### DIRECTIONS

From the Twin Cities, follow US-212 West to Granite Falls, MN. In Granite Falls, MN continue west on MN-67 after crossing US-75 the road west turns to County Road 4 continue west on County Road 4. When entered into Gary, SD turn left on Coteau Street, then turn right onto Main Avenue, continue on this route west out of Gary, SD, approx. 3.5 miles out of town turn right onto 483<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, follow 483<sup>rd</sup> Avenue north for 1 mile then turn left onto 178<sup>th</sup> street and travel approx. 1 mile. Field Trial Camp will be on left. From I-29 coming north or south, take exit 164 (SD-22), head east on SD-22 for approx. 17 miles (traveling through Clear Lake, SD). Turn left on to 483<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, follow 483<sup>rd</sup> Avenue north for 4 miles then turn left onto 178<sup>th</sup> and travel approx. 1 mile. Field trial Camp will be on left.

Camping is allowed on the grounds. Be aware there is no electrical hook-ups on the grounds. Water hydrant is available just below camp at the landowner's cattle corrals

We welcome you to the German Shorthaired Pointer Club's Spring Horseback Field Trial. We are able to hold these ground's on the James Dailey Ranch west of Gary, SD. We discovered these grounds while doing some exploration for some prospective grounds close to Minnesota. These grounds are on an active cattle ranch. Cattle are on these grounds from May to October. The Dailey family has been open to us having our spring trial on this particular 1,900 acre ranch, this is the first ever field trial held here. The Dailey family are very active in conservation they work with conservation groups to manage and keep natural prairies in the best condition under grazing. Since these Grounds are grazed cover is not thick. It is a wide open "pasture" grounds, there are no tree lines, etc. Objectives include taller cover in the coulees and pothole edges. There are numerous pothole wetlands on these grounds so water is abundant on these grounds. Wild Sharptail Grouse have been seen on these grounds last spring as part of the ranch has a lek, ring-neck pheasants are also in the area. There are some fences to contend with, so navigation through some gates will be required through parts of the course (fencing is 3 strand barbwire so a dog can run under these if they are moving forward with the handler). This is our first trial being held here and we hope to make it a success and hope all participants enjoy their time.
