Stay on 169 N, you will pass through the towns of Zimmerman, Princeton, and then Milaca, MN. After passing MN Highway 23 near Milaca, you will go an additional 13.5 miles north on US 169 N. Mille Lacs county road 20 will be on your right, do a U-turn on US 169 and go back south for about 1/4 mile, crossing over Burnt Land Brook. The entrance to the property will be marked with a sign indicating the location of the field event. The property has a 100' tall steel radio tower located in the middle of it. You can't miss it.
